



2020 STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE NOMINATION FORM RULES (2018 By-Laws)

Pursuant to Article V, Section 2 - Any citizen resident in the State of Hawai'i, who is or will be a member of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i for one (1) year before the next election shall be eligible to be a candidate for election to Party Chairperson. Any citizen residing in the State of Hawai'i who wishes to become a candidate for election to Party Chairperson or for election to the State Central Committee shall file a nomination paper with the Secretary of said County or the State Central Committee at least twenty (20) days prior to the State Convention, except that papers for the County Representative seats shall be filed at least ten (10) days prior to the County Convention, and except that papers for the Caucus Representative seats shall be filed after certification by the Caucus, but at least twenty (20) days prior to the State Convention. In the event that no papers have been filed by the filing deadline, the filing deadline shall be extended until ten (10) days prior to the State Convention. However, no additional nomination papers shall be allowed for those positions for which papers had been filed by the filing deadline. If a member has resigned from the Party in the two (2) years prior to re-enrollment in the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, the re-enrolled member must be a member in good standing for at least one (1) year before the next election prior to being elected Party Chairperson or for election to the State Central Committee.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 2B. - The nomination paper of a candidate for Party Chairperson, National Committeeman and National Committeewoman shall be signed by not less than ten (10) certified members of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i from at least two (2) County Organizations. Signatures may be electronic.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 2C. - The nomination paper of a candidate for Youth Representative shall be signed by not less than ten (10) certified members of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, all of whom are members of the Party who are thirty-five (35) years of age or younger.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 2D. - The nomination paper of a candidate for a State Central Committee member shall be signed by not less than five (5) certified members of the Party from the nominee's Senatorial District or Caucuses.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 2E. - The nomination paper for a State Central Committee member filing as a County Representative shall be signed by not less than five (5) certified members of the Party from the nominee's County. All of the above mentioned nominees are elected at the Democratic State Convention, except for the County Representative who is elected from the respective County Convention.

NOTICE: This solicitation is made on behalf of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i (DPH) for both its state and federal campaigns. Contributions to the Federal Account, combined to the state, county, and local Party committees, are limited to \$10,000 per year from individuals and \$5,000 per year from qualified Federal PACs, and will be used in federal and state activities. Contributions from corporations, labor unions, and federal government contractors are prohibited in the federal account. Contributions from individuals and entities are limited to \$25,000 per year to the Non Federal Account. Contributions from foreign nationals and contributions made in the name of another are prohibited in both accounts. Contributions are not tax deductible. Federal and state laws require us to use our best efforts to obtain and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and employer of our donors.
